## A WORD FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

We all start Lent with the best of intentions: with the idea of praying more, being more generous to others, and giving up some of the things that aren't really necessary in our lives. How is that going for you this Lent? It can be like a New Year's resolution that gets broken and then forgotten. Or we can make allowances and exceptions to what we have promised so that it never really gets done. It is time now, in the middle of Lent, to renew our resolution and to do those things which we need to do to be renewed in our relationship with God, with other people and balance our relationship with 'stuff'!

In Lent, we are called back to the grace of baptism. At the moment we left the font at our own baptism, we were as pure as it is possible to be. The sanctifying grace we received totally cleansed us of all sin. It doesn't take long for the cleanliness from sin to get dirtied. This is why we have Sacramental Confession to renew the state of grace within us. Now is the time to return to the Sacrament of Reconciliation! The Church asks us all to make our Confession at least once a year-though this is real minimum. If only we realised how much good for our soul is found in absolution. And yet so many Catholics never go to Confession at all. Why is this? I think there is a growing presumption that God doesn't really mind our sins, which we think of as little. We should realise that all sin injures our relationship with God, and all sin is like poison to our soul.

Over the coming weeks of Lent, there will be extra

times of availability of Confession. Please note these times on page 2 of the bulletin. We will also be having a joint parishes Penitential Service at Burslem in a couple of weeks time. Plan now to be able to get to Confession before Easter, so that we can all celebrate the Feast with hearts made pure and consciences cleansed.

Next Sunday we keep Laetare Sunday, or Mothering Sunday as we know it in England. Let's remember to pray for mothers and grandmothers-those still alive, and those who have departed this life. I will be thinking particularly of my own mother, as it will be the first Mothering Sunday without her with us. It would be great to see families coming together to Mass on Mothering Sunday and praying for a blessing on family life.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK



#### St Maria de Mattias 1805-1866

Maria grew up very protected in a wealthy family. Her father took responsibility to teach her catechism and the Scriptures. As a teenager, she found herself in spiritual darkness. However, after invoking the help of Our Lady, Maria found a mystical insight into the love of the crucified Jesus. Here she found the true source of change for society. Attending a mission preached by St Gaspar de Bufalo, and she was moved to seek the help of a spiritual director. Together they founded the Sisters Adorers of the Blood of Christ. She always spoke about divine realities as someone who had seen them.

**St Patrick's Day** You are invited to come and celebrate the Feast of St Patrick at St Patrick's church on Monday 18th March. The feast is transferred as it occurs on a Sunday in Lent. There will be Mass at 6.30pm followed by a bring and share buffet in the church porch. Everyone is welcome.
